

UK Parliament to debate banning non-stun slaughter

Petition filed states that
non-stun slaughter is
“barbaric” and doesn’t
fit in with British value



On the 9th of June 2025 Parliament will debate a petition signed by over a hundred thousand people to ban non-stunned slaughter here in the UK.

It comes after a petition was filed to ‘Ban non-stun slaughter in the UK’, and which garnered over 109,000 signatures. It claims “In modern society, we believe more consideration needs to be given to animal welfare and how livestock is treated and culled. We believe non-stun slaughter is barbaric and doesn’t fit in with our culture and modern-day values and should be banned, as some EU nations have done.”

Kayan's race against time

12-year-old's fight for life after kidney failure linked to tainted medication

A family from Sheffield is urgently appealing for support as their 12-year-old son, Kayan, faces a life-threatening battle with kidney failure, triggered by what has now been identified as a toxic batch of prescribed vitamin D.

Kayan, described by his family as a bright and courageous young boy, has been living with chronic kidney disease for much of his life.

Despite being non-verbal, using a wheelchair, and managing complex health and sensory needs, Kayan has always met life with resilience and a radiant smile.

For years, his kidney function remained stable at Stage 3, and his family worked tirelessly to provide a loving, supportive environment. But in recent months, that stability was shattered.

Following the administration of a contaminated supplement,

Kayan's condition rapidly deteriorated, pushing him into end-stage renal failure.

Now, time is running out.

Doctors estimate Kayan has less than two years to live without a transplant.

However, the NHS kidney transplant waiting list currently spans up to three years - longer than Kayan can afford to wait.

"Kayan's health decline has been devastating," says his mother. "He's constantly fatigued, in and out of hospital, and enduring intensive treatments that no child should have to face."

In response, the family has launched an emergency fundraising campaign to seek a private kidney transplant, with the goal of raising £70,000 to cover the surgery and essential aftercare. The cost includes £42,000 for the procedure and an additional £6,700 annually for ongoing post-operative care.

"This transplant is not just a procedure - it's a lifeline," his parents share.

"We just want Kayan to have a chance. A chance to grow, to explore the world in his own way, and to simply feel well again."

They are now appealing to the community, the public, and anyone moved by Kayan's story to consider contributing.

"Every donation, no matter the size, will directly impact his life, bringing us closer to the day he can receive a healthy kidney and finally have the opportunity to live his life to the fullest, free from the immediate threat of kidney failure caused by this unforeseen event," pleads Kayan's mum.

"Please consider donating and sharing Kayan's story with your network. Your generosity will offer him the precious gift of life and renewed hope for a brighter future."

Current UK law requires all animals to be stunned before slaughter; however, the law provides an exemption for the Muslim and Jewish community to slaughter without stunning.

A small percentage of Halal slaughter is non-stunned here in the UK and all Shechita (Jewish) slaughter is non-stunned, both collectively only representing a small percentage of slaughter overall.

All non-stunned Halal slaughter in the UK and EU is carried out humanely, in fully licensed and regulated slaughterhouses, adhering strictly to animal welfare laws.

These practices take place in the same controlled environments and under the same rigorous standards as conventional slaughter, ensuring the

highest level of care and dignity for the animals at every stage.

The Halal Monitoring Committee (HMC), UK’s largest certifying body - and a registered charity, is in communication with other partner groups to respond and contribute to this debate and will communicate this to the Muslim community in due course.

HMC says: “It would be highly beneficial to contact your local MP and clarify their understanding and view on this debate. Unfortunately, there is lots of misinformation being circulated on social media which is not only inaccurate but shared to demonise the Muslim community and create hate.”

Bradford 2025 exhibition showcases how families kept in touch across the globe through cassette tapes

“Tape letters to Pakistan”



They may look old-fashioned now, but cassette tapes once carried voices, love, and family news thousands of miles across the globe, and Bradford’s British Pakistani community is celebrating this long-lost connection with a special new exhibition.

The exhibition - ‘Tape Letters’, opened on 22nd May at Bradford 2025’s Loading Bay Gallery in Duke Street, and shines a spotlight on a remarkable way families kept in touch before the internet or cheap phone calls.

Between the 1960s and ’80s, many British Pakistanis sent audio cassette tapes filled with personal messages back home - a heartfelt, intimate lifeline bridging two worlds.

Curated especially for Bradford 2025, the show tells the stories of 12 local families through photographs, quotes, and the very tapes themselves. From romantic love notes to everyday family updates, the exhibition reveals how these humble cassettes captured emotions and moments that letters or calls simply couldn’t.

“We’d sit around the tape recorder like it was breaking news,” recalls Bradford’s Asaf Hussain.

“My mum wanted every detail - who was sick, who was visiting. For us kids, it was just hearing Dad’s voice. It was like he was right there with us.”

For many, sending tape letters was not only practical, but cheaper than international calls, and a

way to speak freely.

Bradford’s Asma Mirza remembers the shy beginnings of a romance through secret cassette exchanges.

“There was no cordless phone, and I couldn’t even say hello in front of my family. So Asim sent me a tape and told me, ‘Tell me what’s in your heart.’ I kept those tapes locked away like precious treasures.”

The project was dreamed up by Modus Arts, who have been uncovering this hidden audio archive since 2018. Director Wajid Yaseen discovered his own family’s cassette history and soon found hundreds of others across the UK sharing similar stories.

“It’s like sonic archaeology - digging through memory, migration, culture, and the power of human connection,” says Wajid. “It shows how deeply people want to communicate, no matter where they are in the world.”

Shanaz Gulzar, Creative Director of Bradford 2025, added: “I remember sitting with my family, recording messages to relatives I’d never met. Sometimes the tapes came back mixed with Culture Club songs - cultural fusion before we knew it!”



Running until 15 June, Tape Letters invites visitors to tune in, listen, and celebrate a truly unique chapter in Bradford’s rich cultural history - when voices on cassette kept families close, across continents and decades.

Community power!

Groundbreaking domestic abuse in South Asian homes programme hailed a “game-changer”

A powerful new programme aimed at tackling domestic abuse in South Asian communities has been hailed as a “game-changer” in the fight against violence behind closed doors.

The Changing Harmful Attitudes and Behaviour (CHAB) initiative was launched at a powerful community event hosted by H.O.P.E CIC, with support from Sikh Women’s Aid, Pegasus Ltd, and the Halo Project.

The launch, held in Bradford, brought together community leaders, survivors, support workers, and experts - all united in their mission to bring real, lasting change.

“This isn’t just another programme - this is about saving lives,” said Meena Kumari, Director at H.O.P.E CIC.

“We’ve created something by our community, for our community.”

Running from February 2025 to April 2026, CHAB became the first programme of its kind co-designed and led by South Asian experts. It focuses not only on helping survivors of abuse, but also on challenging those who cause harm - in a way that understands culture, faith and family dynamics.

The event showcased how CHAB will combine therapy, education, and behaviour change support, while placing victim safety at the centre of everything.

“It’s time we tackled abuse at the root,” said Yasmin Khan, CEO of the Halo Project. “For too long, cultural barriers have stopped us from properly addressing these issues. CHAB is a brave and necessary step.”

One of the most moving parts of the launch was hearing directly from those who have seen the impact of abuse up close - and who believe CHAB offers new hope.

“Victims need to be protected, but the behaviour also needs to stop,” said Suki Kaur, Trustee at Sikh Women’s Aid.

“We’ll be there to support survivors every step of the way, while the programme works to change behaviour safely.”

Imran Manzoor of Pegasus Ltd added: “We’ve worked with South Asian men for years. This is the first time we’ve had a space that allows honest, open reflection—without judgement, but with accountability.”

Guest speaker Dr Ikram Butt also voiced his full support, saying: “CHAB is vital. It tackles harmful behaviours where they begin and offers a real route to change. We need more work like this - led by communities, with purpose and heart.”

CHAB is now hosting free information sessions online and in-person to explain how the programme works and how local communities can get involved.

Apprentice joiner, 21, gears up to take on the world at the 'Skills Olympics' From Bradford to Shanghai!



A talented young joiner from Bradford is getting ready to take on the world after being handpicked for Squad UK- the national team training for WorldSkills 2026, the global showdown dubbed the "Skills Olympics."

Ahmed Shakir, 21, who works for local firm Abrahams & Carlisle and studies at Bradford College, has already proved he's one of Britain's brightest young tradesmen after a dazzling performance at this year's 'SkillBuild' competition.

Now, he's preparing to swap Yorkshire for Shanghai, where the world's top apprentices and students will battle it out in front of 250,000 spectators in the biggest vocational skills competition on the planet.

"I'm over the moon," Ahmed said. "This is a once-in-a-lifetime chance. The training will be tough, but I'm going to give it everything."

Ahmed is one of just four joinery apprentices selected for the UK squad and will now undergo 18-months of intense training, guided by industry experts and former champions.

WorldSkills 2026 will see 1,500 competitors from more than 80 countries go head-to-head in 30+ skills ranging from digital tech and engineering to construction and hospitality.

"After proving himself as one of the country's best young joiners, Ahmed will now get the chance to do it all over again- this time on a global scale," said Ben Blackledge, CEO of WorldSkills UK.

"This is about excellence, ambition, and showing what British talent can achieve."

Ahmed's journey started just three years ago, when he joined Bradford College's joinery course. He completed his Level 1 and 2 qualifications before landing an apprenticeship with Abrahams & Carlisle in 2023. Since then, he hasn't looked back.

"They've been amazing," Ahmed

said. "They helped me prepare for SkillBuild, even took my tools all the way to Milton Keynes. I wouldn't be here without their support - and Bradford College has backed me from day one."

His boss, Jonathan Hemingway, couldn't be prouder. "He's got real talent and the drive to match it," he

said.

"He's going places - and we're behind him all the way."

Now, with his eye on the prize, Ahmed is determined to make the most of the opportunity. "Shanghai is a long way from Bradford," he laughed. "But if I can bring home a medal, it'll all be worth it."

SHEFFIELD'S NEW LORD MAYOR

"I stand before you today in great pride and joy, it is more than an honour, I am honoured to be the first black woman wearing a hijab to take this role."

Sheffield has made history as Safiya Saeed becomes the city's new Right Worshipful Lord Mayor - the first Black woman wearing a hijab to hold the prestigious title.

The 128th person to wear the mayoral chains, Councillor Saeed was officially sworn in at Sheffield City Council's Annual General Meeting, where her proud family watched from the chamber - some having flown in especially from her homeland of Somaliland to mark the momentous occasion.

Standing tall in her ceremonial robes, the mother-of-five spoke with emotion: "I stand before you today in great pride and joy. It is more than an honour - I am honoured to be the first Black woman wearing a hijab to take this role."

It's a deeply personal victory for Safiya, who arrived in Sheffield back in 1985 and has since dedicated her life to public service and community activism. Her journey from immigrant teenager to the

city's top civic figure is nothing short of inspirational.

A single mother raising five children, Safiya has never shied away from a challenge. She has served as Deputy Lord Mayor and chaired the North East Local Area Committee, earning respect across the political spectrum. But it's her grassroots work that has left the biggest mark.

As founder of Reach Up Youth, Safiya has empowered hundreds of young people, particularly from Black and ethnic minority backgrounds, providing leadership training, workshops, access to vital services, and safe spaces where they can grow and thrive.

"My children have taught me the value of nurturing future generations," she shared. "That's what Reach Up Youth is all about. It's about helping young people believe in themselves."

Outside of her civic duties, Safiya is a self-confessed people-person, who loves travel, networking, and learning. She aims to transform Sheffield into a buzzing hub of collaboration, bringing together entrepreneurs, charities, investors, and everyday residents to build a more unified, prosperous city.

"I came to Sheffield in 1985, and this city has truly become my home - a place where I have always felt I belong," she said. "I want every voice, no matter how quiet, to feel heard in the heart of this city."

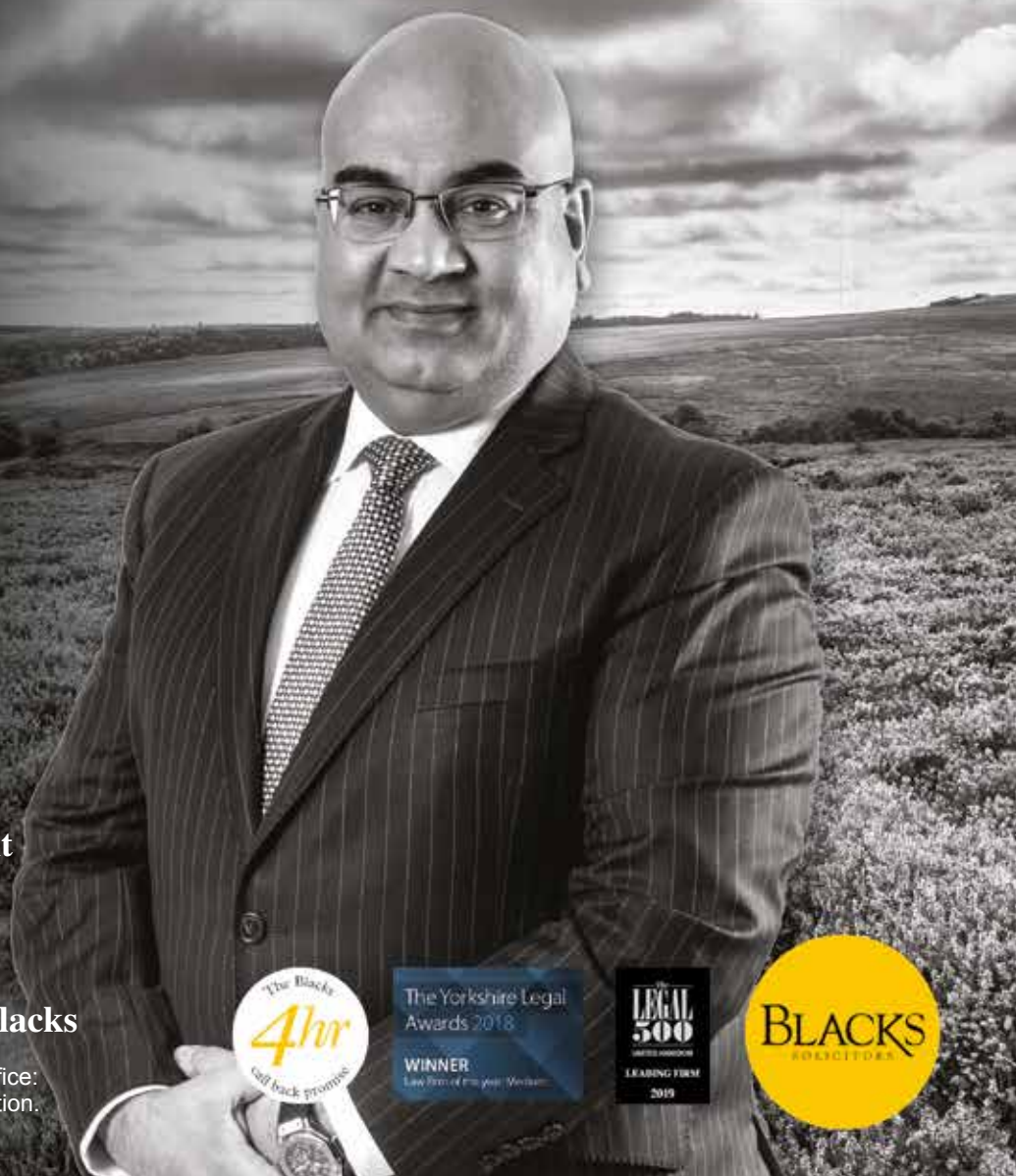

Breaking barriers in healthcare

Leeds author Heena Mahmood launches groundbreaking book on racial equity

A bold new voice is rising in the call for racial equity in healthcare.

Heena Mahmood, a respected NHS leader and practice as a Senior Specialist Physiotherapist who's deeply involved in advocacy and leadership, has released her debut book, 'Minority Ethnic Voices in Healthcare Professions' - a powerful and much-needed exploration of racial inequality within the UK's healthcare system.

Launched at a packed event at Leeds Civic Hall, the book offers compelling case studies and first-hand interviews with healthcare workers from ethnic minority backgrounds, ranging from support staff to senior executives. "This book gives voice to those too often spoken about, but rarely heard," said Heena during her launch speech. "It's about time we centre the perspectives of minority ethnic professionals in the conversations that directly affect them."

Heena's insights come from personal and professional experience. As a trailblazer in the NHS, she founded the



first BAME staff network in a large NHS trust and was a key figure in the award-winning West Yorkshire regional race equality initiative.

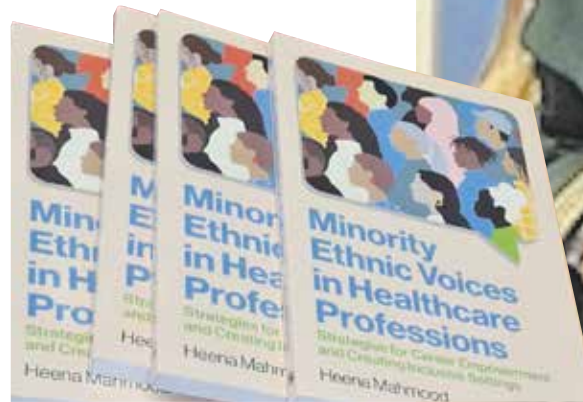
Her work spans both digital healthcare innovation and frontline physiotherapy, giving her a unique lens into the layered challenges ethnic minority staff face.

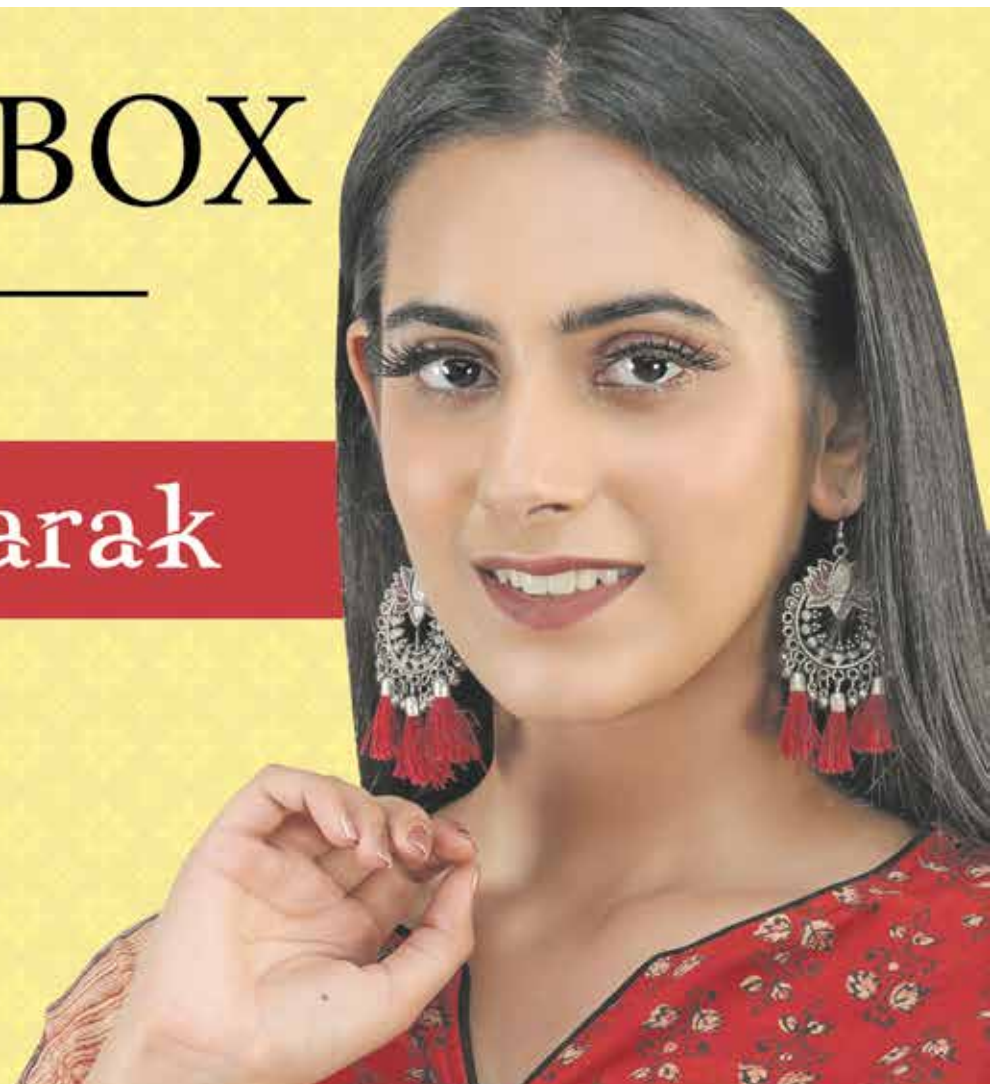

Supporting students at risk of exclusion from school

A new alternative provision aimed at supporting students at risk of exclusion has officially opened in Bradford.

Link AP Academy, located at Listerhills Science Park on Campus Road, held its grand opening event last month, welcoming key stakeholders and education professionals from across the district.

Founded and managed by Shazad Ali, the academy offers a specialist learning environment for students aged 11 to 16 in Key Stages 3 and 4 (Years 7 to 11). The initiative is designed to re-engage pupils who face permanent exclusion, are vulnerable to criminal exploitation, or have special educational needs.

The opening of Link AP Academy comes as recent data revealed a worrying trend in Bradford schools, with one institution recording an exclusion and suspension rate 15 times higher than the national average.

Ten schools in the city were found to have rates at least four times higher than the national figure of 3.54 exclusions per 100 pupils.

Speaking at the opening, Mr. Ali highlighted the increasing challenges schools face since the Covid-19 pandemic. "There has been an

ever-increasing number of exclusions from schools," he said.

"Schools are struggling financially, and students' learning gaps are widening. We offer a small, focused setting where students can receive one-on-one support tailored to their emotional, social, and academic needs."

The academy will deliver core subjects including maths, English, and science, as well as vocational pathways, all taught by fully qualified teachers. The aim is to prepare students for a return to mainstream education or to help them transition into employment.

Alison Lowe, Deputy Mayor of West Yorkshire for Policing and Crime, and Karen Cruise, CEO of Flourished Minds, were among the attendees at the launch event.

Mr. Ali, who previously worked at Bradford Academy and grew up in the city, said he launched Link AP Academy to give back to the community.

"As the founder, I am committed to creating a nurturing and dynamic learning environment where every student is given the opportunity to succeed," he said. "Bradford needs more opportunities like this - a breath of fresh air to support our young people."

A pair of master forgers who made over £1 million supplying fake UK identity documents to high-profile criminals have been jailed.

Bilal Iqbal, 25, and Ummad Ahmed, 32, both from east London, pleaded guilty to a total of five charges, including making false identity documents and money laundering. On 22 May, at Snaresbrook Crown Court, a judge sentenced both Iqbal and Ahmed to six years' imprisonment each, half of which will be served on licence.

The duo's criminal enterprise came to light during a separate NCA investigation into international drug trafficker Eddie Burton.

He purchased a fake ID from Iqbal and Ahmed, and used it to travel across borders in mainland Europe. From there he imported over 300 kilos of Class A drugs into the UK.

Fake identity documents can also assist irregular migrants smuggled into the UK on small boats and in lorries. They can be used to gain employment, open bank accounts and commit acts of fraud to claim benefits and housing.

Iqbal and Ahmed charged around £70 for a fake UK driving licence and offered a range of optional extras, such as holographic stickers or raised text, for an additional cost. Customers could also pay £40 for an express service to receive their ID in three or four days, as opposed to two to three weeks.

NCA investigators estimate the pair sold more than 40,000 fake IDs – an average of around 100 per week – over an eight-year period. They made more than £1 million and laundered their illicit profits through a window cleaning company.

Both men were arrested by NCA officers on 21 January 2025, hours before they were due to board a flight to Dubai.

At the time of his arrest Iqbal was carrying envelopes containing 19 fake UK driving licences, and 21 more were seized from his car and home in Ilford.

Items seized from Ahmed's home address in Hornchurch included an ID card printer, laminator, blank plastic cards, holographic foil and over £20,000 in cash.

John Turner, NCA senior investigating officer, said: "These men ran an extremely lucrative illegal enterprise and operated as professional enablers at the heart of serious and organised crime.

"These IDs helped high-profile criminals evade law enforcement and operate anonymously. They could also be used by offenders involved in organised immigration crime to provide people smuggled into the country with false UK identities.

"Tackling enablers for wider criminality, such as Iqbal and Ahmed, is a key pillar in our mission to protect the public from serious and organised crime."

Park-goers reminded about BBQ ban in Leeds parks



As Leeds enjoys summer temperatures, park visitors are reminded that barbecues are not permitted in the city's parks, to protect the parks and their wildlife.

Whilst barbecues and any other fire lighting is banned from Leeds's parks and greenspaces, picnics are more than welcome.

Barbecues increase the risk of accidental fires caused by ash and falling embers, which can spread very quickly on dry grass. They can

also cause damage to the natural environment and have devastating effect on local wildlife and vegetation.

Visitors are also reminded to take litter home or place it in bins, as littering can become a fire hazard. Glass bottles left lying around in the sun can lead to fires, as can cigarettes thrown on the ground.

Wildfires are very common in the UK, with the National Fire Chiefs Council having warned that 2025 may be the worst year yet. Marsden

Moor has been severely damaged in a significant wildfire this spring, and earlier this month firefighters tackled a moorland blaze near the M62 which burned in two directions, stretching about 2km each way.

Councillor Mohammed Rafique, Leeds City Council's executive member for climate, energy, environment and green space, said: "Every year as we start getting nice weather in Leeds, we love seeing people out and enjoying the sunshine in our parks and greenspaces.

"We do need to really raise awareness and remind people that we don't allow barbecues or any kind of fire lighting, and that littering can also start fires.

"I know it can seem like a harmless thing, but barbecues and littering can lead to fires that are devastating for the wildlife, and our parks, so please bring a picnic to the park instead!

"If you do see a grass fire, please call 999."

West Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service's assistant district commander

for Leeds, Aaron Clark, said: "We're lucky enough to have some great green spaces here in Leeds but we just really want people to enjoy them safely. That includes things like not taking barbecues to parks or grassy areas – they can get hot and cause a lot of damage.

"For our crews, outdoor fires can be really intensive to tackle and take up a lot of resources, so it's best for the whole community if you can help us by leaving barbecues at home."

Act Promptly or Lose the Right to Light

Developers can face numerous regulatory obstacles before they are able to complete developments, such as planning issues and compliance with building safety regulations. One issue which is sometimes overlooked but can prove extremely costly for developers are claims for “right to light”. A right to light is a legal easement that gives a property owner the right to enjoy the light passing over somebody else’s land. If the neighbouring property owner has a right to light and there is no agreement in place with the developer, then it can prove costly for the developer as the property owner could apply to the Court for an order that the development be reduced in size or even for an offending building to be demolished.

The recent High Court case of Handstone Investments Limited v Abri Group Limited provides useful guidance as to when the Court will grant an injunction to halt a development which interferes with a neighbouring property owner’s right to light.

In that case, Abri intended to build a 4-storey building containing 33 affordable housing flats opposite a commercial office block owned by

Handstone. The office block enjoyed a right of light over adjoining land, and the proposed development would have blocked the passage of light to the offices. Compensation was offered by Abri, but Handstone wanted the development to be cut back to restrict the loss of light. Eight months into the build, Handstone applied for an Interim injunction to halt the building works pending determination of its entitlement to a Final Injunction to restrict the development.

In considering whether or not to grant the Interim Injunction, the Court had to consider the following factors:

1. Whether there is a serious issue to be tried?
2. Would damages be an adequate remedy?
3. Where does the balance of convenience lie?
4. Are there any other special factors to be considered?

The Judge refused to grant the Interim Injunction because:

- Handstone was not in occupation of the office block itself, but it owned the property for investment purposes.
- Handstone had failed to act promptly in applying for the Injunction, it had only done so after the building works had commenced.
- The development was in the public interest as it provided much needed housing.
- There had been no material complaint from the office block tenants, except for an objection during the planning stage of the development.

This decision is a reminder that when seeking urgent remedies from the Court a party must act promptly as any delay is likely to defeat their entitlement to the remedy. It is also a helpful case for developers who encounter claims for right to light from adjoining property owners.

Seven tips to keep your smart devices at home safe from hackers

Smart devices in people’s homes have surged in popularity over the last 10 years, items including video doorbells, smart speakers and smart kitchen appliances becoming part of everyday life.

Smart devices can be monitored and controlled remotely by the homeowner

through apps on their mobile phone; but research has revealed that smart home devices are now subjected to an average of 10 attacks per day.

In 2023, the most vulnerable categories included Smart TVs (34% of vulnerabilities), Smart plugs (18%) and Digital video recorders (13%).

The University of Bradford has teamed up with the Universities of Sheffield and North Texas and National University of Singapore on its research into Internet of Things, a network of internet-connected smart devices used in homes, and artificial intelligence (AI).

Dr Sohag Kabir, Associate Professor at the University of Bradford’s School of Computer Science, Artificial Intelligence and Electronics, has given homeowners tips to keep their devices as safe as possible from the threat of hackers.

Dr Kabir also reveals ways hackers

can carry out cyber-attacks on devices in our homes such as smart TVs or smart plugs. He says hackers can guess weak or default passwords and urged people to change them. Hackers can also exploit outdated software in smart devices and if they don’t have built-in security, they are vulnerable to attacks.



TOP TIPS

- **Change Default Passwords Immediately:** Don’t leave the factory-set password on your smart TV, camera, or plug. Use strong, unique passwords that you don’t use elsewhere.
- **Don’t Re-use Passwords Across Devices:** If one account gets hacked, reused passwords can give hackers access to everything else - including your smart home.
- **Update Devices and Apps Regularly:** Just like phones or computers, smart devices get security updates. Install them as soon as they’re available to patch known holes.
- **Use Strong Wi-Fi Security:** Set your Wi-Fi to use Wi-Fi Protected Access 3 (WPA3), or at least WPA2 encryption, and use a strong, unique password for your network.
- **Turn Off Features You Don’t Use:** Disable remote access, voice control, or Bluetooth if you’re not using them - fewer features mean fewer ways in.
- **Buy from Reputable Brands:** Choose devices from trusted manufacturers who provide regular updates and support. Cheap no-name gadgets often come with poor or no security.
- **Keep an Eye on What’s Connected:** Regularly check your router’s admin page or app to see which devices are connected. Remove anything unfamiliar.



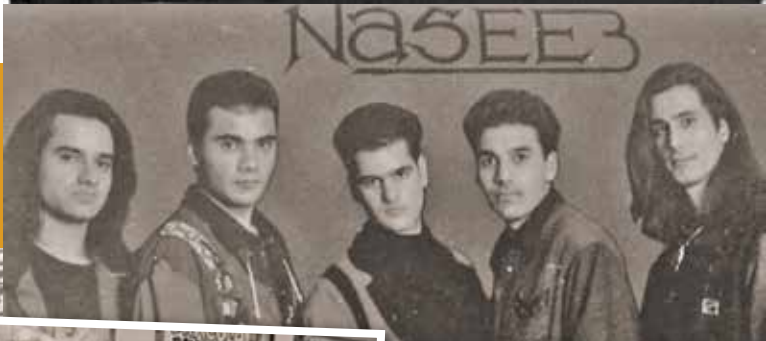

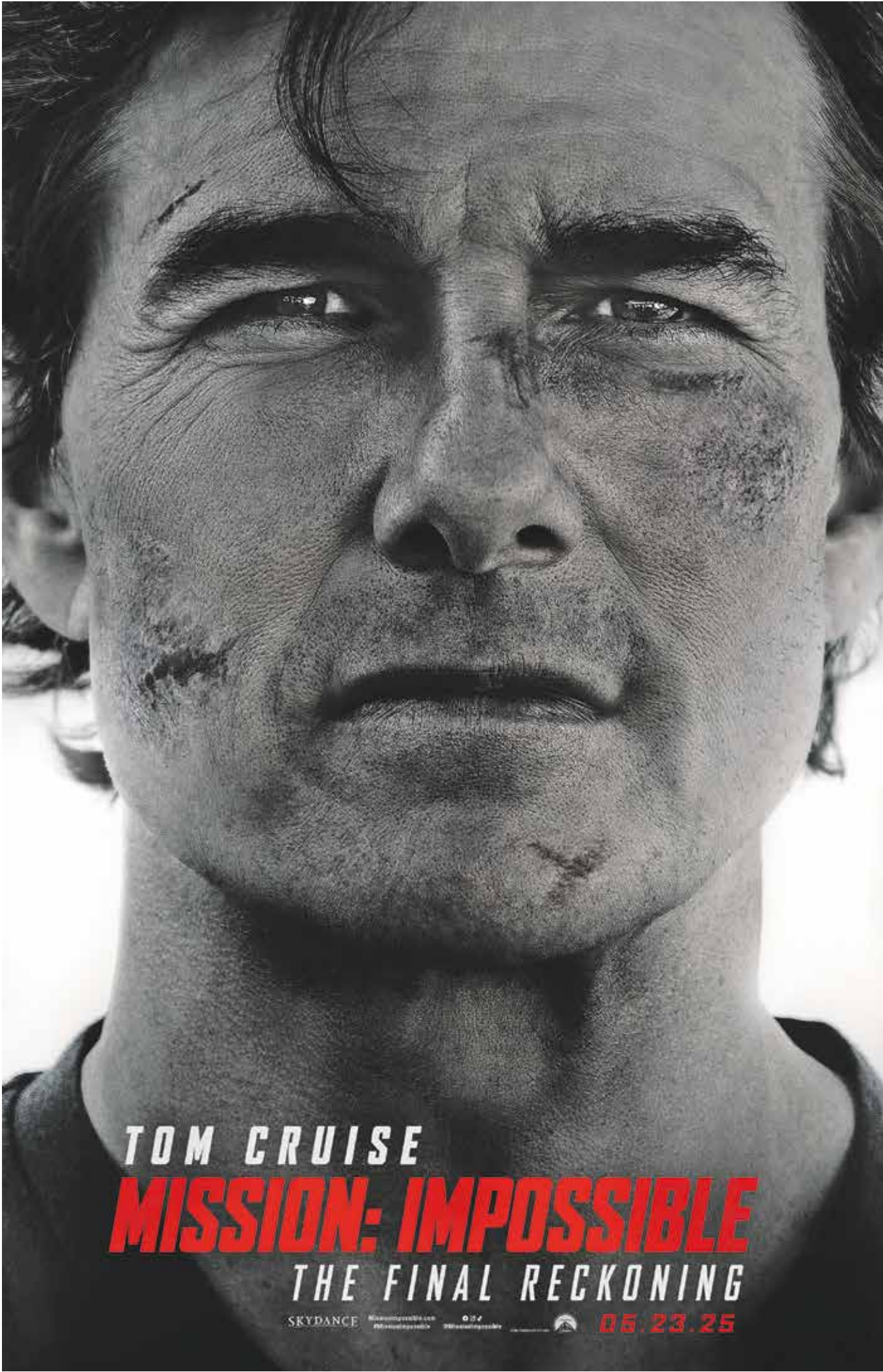

The stakes are higher than ever before. The threat posed by the ‘Entity’ - a rogue, sentient artificial intelligence that has infiltrated the world’s digital infrastructure, destabilising global systems and endangering the very survival of the human race.

Once again, it falls on the shoulders of veteran IMF agent Ethan Hunt, played by the ever-committed Tom Cruise, to prevent disaster and save the world from total annihilation.

While this film follows directly from 2023’s Dead Reckoning, continuing the storyline of the Entity, it also functions as a culmination of the Mission: Impossible franchise as a whole.

In many ways, it plays like a grand retrospective, tipping its hat to nearly three decades of cinematic espionage. Yet, while Final Reckoning honours its roots, it also boldly expands the scope of the series. Departing from the tightly constructed spy-thrillers of its earlier chapters, this entry unfolds on a massive, almost apocalyptic scale.

Writer-director Christopher McQuarrie, returning for his fourth outing with the franchise, doesn’t shy away from the ambitious storytelling this world-ending threat demands. The world portrayed here is one teetering on the edge of chaos — governments have collapsed, nuclear weapons are compromised, and global order is a memory. This is not just another mission; it’s a war, with the future of humanity hanging in the balance.

Action-wise, Final Reckoning is surprisingly restrained in its first half, focusing instead on building character and theme. But when the action finally explodes, it does so in spectacular fashion.

The climax of the film is a breathtaking aerial showdown, with Cruise performing stunts that defy belief, leaping between biplanes in a high-altitude dogfight that must be seen to be believed. It’s a masterclass in practical effects and sheer cinematic bravado, showcasing Tom Cruise’s unwavering commitment to delivering spectacle on the grandest scale.

Mission: Impossible - The Final Reckoning delivers both on action and emotion. Its slow-building, tension-filled narrative gives way to some of the most exhilarating sequences in the series, ending on a triumphant high note. It’s a love letter to fans, a bold statement on modern filmmaking, and potentially, a well-earned farewell to one of cinema’s greatest action heroes.

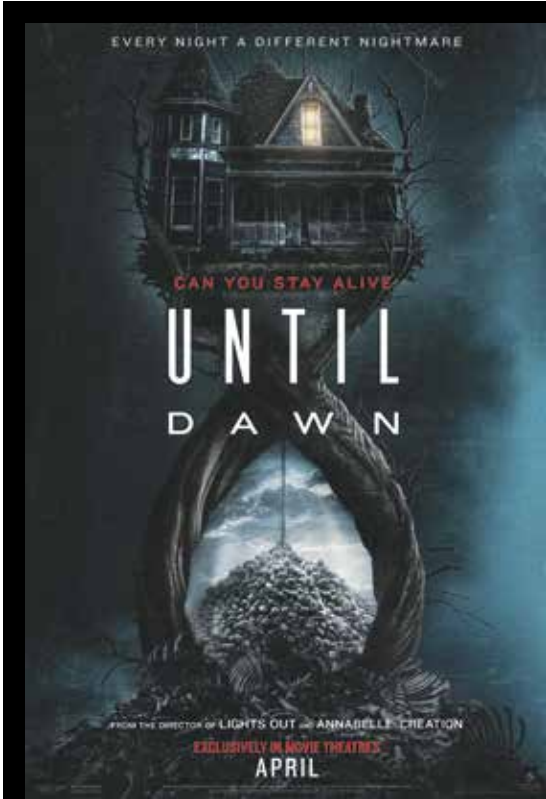
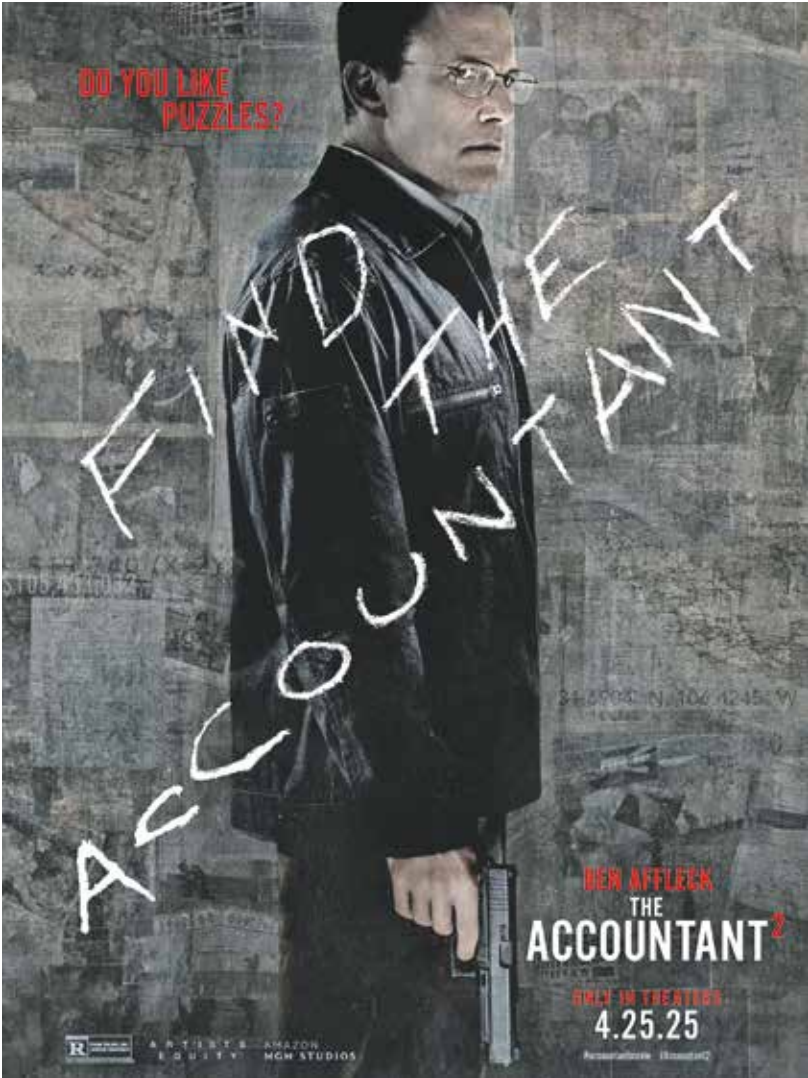

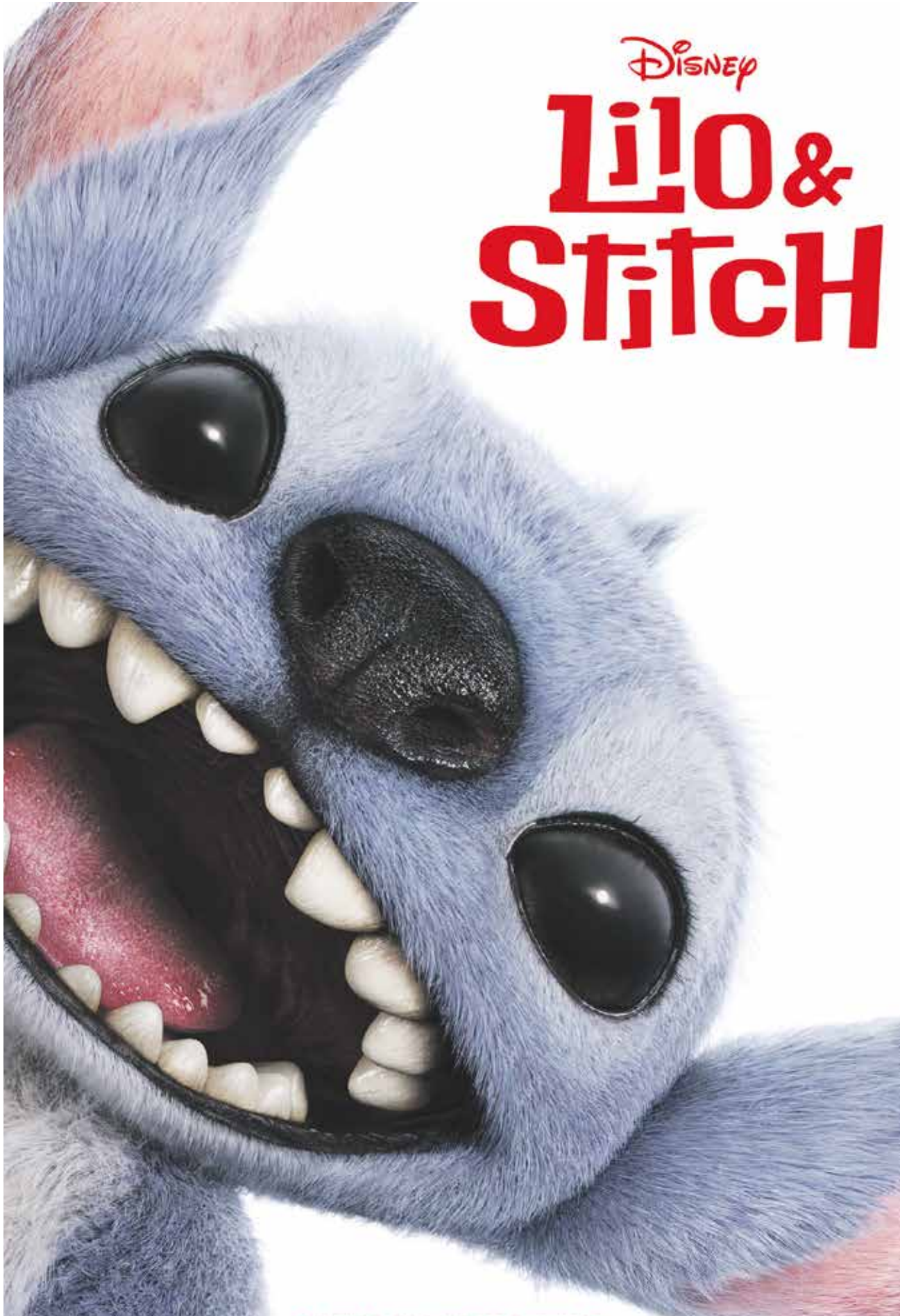

The latter looked at Porsche's 641-horsepower autobahn assassin and thought, "What if it was lower, wider, louder, meaner, and could suck itself to the tarmac like a vacuum cleaner on performance-enhancing drugs?" Then they actually built it.

Welcome to the RML P39 — a hypercar so bonkers it debuted not on a racetrack, but on a runway. Specifically, Supercar Fest The Runway 2025, where the only noise louder than the P39's bespoke Inconel exhaust was the collective jaw-drop of spectators when it went full throttle down Sywell Aerodrome.

And then, as if that wasn't enough, it deployed a wing that moved like a Transformer doing yoga.

HEADER: What is it?

Well, it was a Porsche 992.1 Turbo S. But then RML - the British firm known for building race cars, super tourers, and anything else fast enough to bend space-time - got their hands on it.

What they created is the P39, a limited-run hypercar built to celebrate 40 years of engineering excellence... or perhaps midlife crisis.

Only 39 of these will ever exist, which means it's more exclusive than most royal family weddings and significantly more entertaining.

At first glance, it's still recognisably a Porsche. But then the eye catches the flared arches, the ground-scraping front splitter, the mammoth rear diffuser, and a rear wing that would look excessive on a 747.

The entire body has been re-sculpted in carbon fibre — not because it needed to be, but because RML could. It's not just pretty; it's clever.

Active aero at the front and rear changes depending on your driving mode. In Road mode, it's subtle. In Track mode, the splitter extends, the wing grows fangs, and downforce jumps to an astonishing 6,500 newtons at 150 mph. That's more than some actual race cars. It's like driving around with a polite anvil pushing you into the tarmac.

There's even DRS — yes, like Formula One. Press a button and the wing flattens for maximum speed on the straights. Because why not?

Underneath: A chassis tighter than your skinny jeans

To manage all that extra grip, RML has completely redone the suspension. It's wider. It's lower. It's firmer when you want it to be and gentle when you don't.

There's a hydraulic lift system to handle speed bumps (or large insects), and triple-mode dampers for every mood: Calm, Sporty, and "I Can Smell the Tyres Melting."

Even the rear-wheel steering has been retuned. The result? A car that corners like a housefly and cruises like a grand tourer. This thing is faster than sense but somehow still usable. You could, in theory, take it to Waitrose. Though you probably shouldn't — unless you're trying to scare pensioners in the car park.

Power: 920hp. Because 900 was too sensible

Now the juicy bit. Underneath its surgically enhanced rear end lies a twin-turbo flat-six that's had more work done than a Kardashian family reunion. In partnership with Litchfield Motors, RML has pumped it up to 920 horsepower and 705lb-ft of torque.

There are modes for every occasion:

- **Wet: 600hp for when Britain is doing its usual soggy thing**
- **Normal: 750hp for fast road blasts**
- **Sport/Sport+: All 920 angry horses unleashed, like a stampede of very expensive unicorns**

And yes, all that's backed by a 12-month warranty. Because apparently, you can buy a rocket-powered Porsche with more software updates than your iPhone.

So, what's it like?

In a word: mad. But the good kind. The kind that makes your heart skip a beat, then demands you take the long way home - preferably via the Nürburgring.

What makes it truly impressive is that RML hasn't just made a track monster.

They've made a track monster that thinks, one that adapts, one that doesn't punish you for not wearing a Nomex race suit. On the track, it's savage. On the road, it's smooth. It's Jekyll and Hyde, except both are wearing carbon-fibre helmets.

Michael Mallock, the man behind RML's bespoke division, puts it best:

"We wanted a car that could switch personalities at the touch of a button - serene on the road, savage on the circuit."

Job done, Michael.

Verdict: Should You Want One?

Of course, you should. If you have a pulse and a garage, the P39 should be on your dream list. It's rarer than a polite YouTube comment and more versatile than a Leatherman.

Only 39 will be built, and the first UK deliveries start summer 2025.

If you're lucky enough to get your hands on one, congratulations. You've not just bought a car — you've bought into 40 years of engineering distilled into one hell of a statement.

It's not just a celebration of RML's past. It's a burning rubber postcard from the future - with a wing.

100 Miles for Gaza:

Running trio raises £21K in epic two-day challenge

A trio of determined volunteers from Slough have completed an incredible 100-mile run from Leicester to London in just 36 hours, raising more than £21,000 — and counting - for Islamic Relief UK's Gaza emergency appeal.

Runners Mohsin, Shafqat, and Wajid, took on the challenge over the May bank holiday weekend, setting off at 5am on Sunday 4th May from Madina Masjid in Leicester, and crossing the finish line at Shepherd's Bush Masjid in London by 6pm on Monday 5th May.

Along the way, they ran through multiple towns and cities, stopping overnight at Luton Central Masjid, where they were warmly welcomed by the local community.

Covering an average of 50 miles per day - the equivalent of nearly two marathons a day. The group endured fatigue, muscle soreness, and intense weather conditions. But for the runners, every step was worth it.

"Every day since the crisis began, we've seen awful scenes of destruction and suffering in Gaza on the news and social media," the team said.

"It can make you feel helpless, like there's nothing you can do. But we were determined to act - not just to raise funds, but to send a message of solidarity to our brothers and sisters in Palestine. This was our way of saying: you are not alone."

Responding to crisis

The run was inspired by the deepening humanitarian crisis in Gaza, where ongoing conflict has left a devastating toll on the civilian population.

Since October 2023, Islamic Relief has been delivering life-saving aid to Palestinian families under siege. Over £39 million worth of humanitarian support has been distributed so far, including over 70 million hot meals, hygiene kits, medical supplies, and emergency shelter.

Despite this, the situation remains dire. According to Islamic Relief UK, around 90% of Gaza's population has been forcibly displaced, with over 52,000 Palestinians killed and many more injured. Access to clean water, food, electricity, and medical care remains extremely limited.

"The scale of the devastation is difficult to comprehend," said Zia Salik, Deputy Director and Head of Fundraising at Islamic Relief UK.

"Our teams on the ground in Gaza are working around the clock under impossible conditions. But thanks to fundraising efforts like this — powered by ordinary people doing extraordinary things — we are able to continue reaching families who urgently need help."

A community effort

While the runners completed the physical challenge, they credit the wider community for helping make it possible. Leicester's Imam Khalid Hussain provided guidance and moral support at the outset.

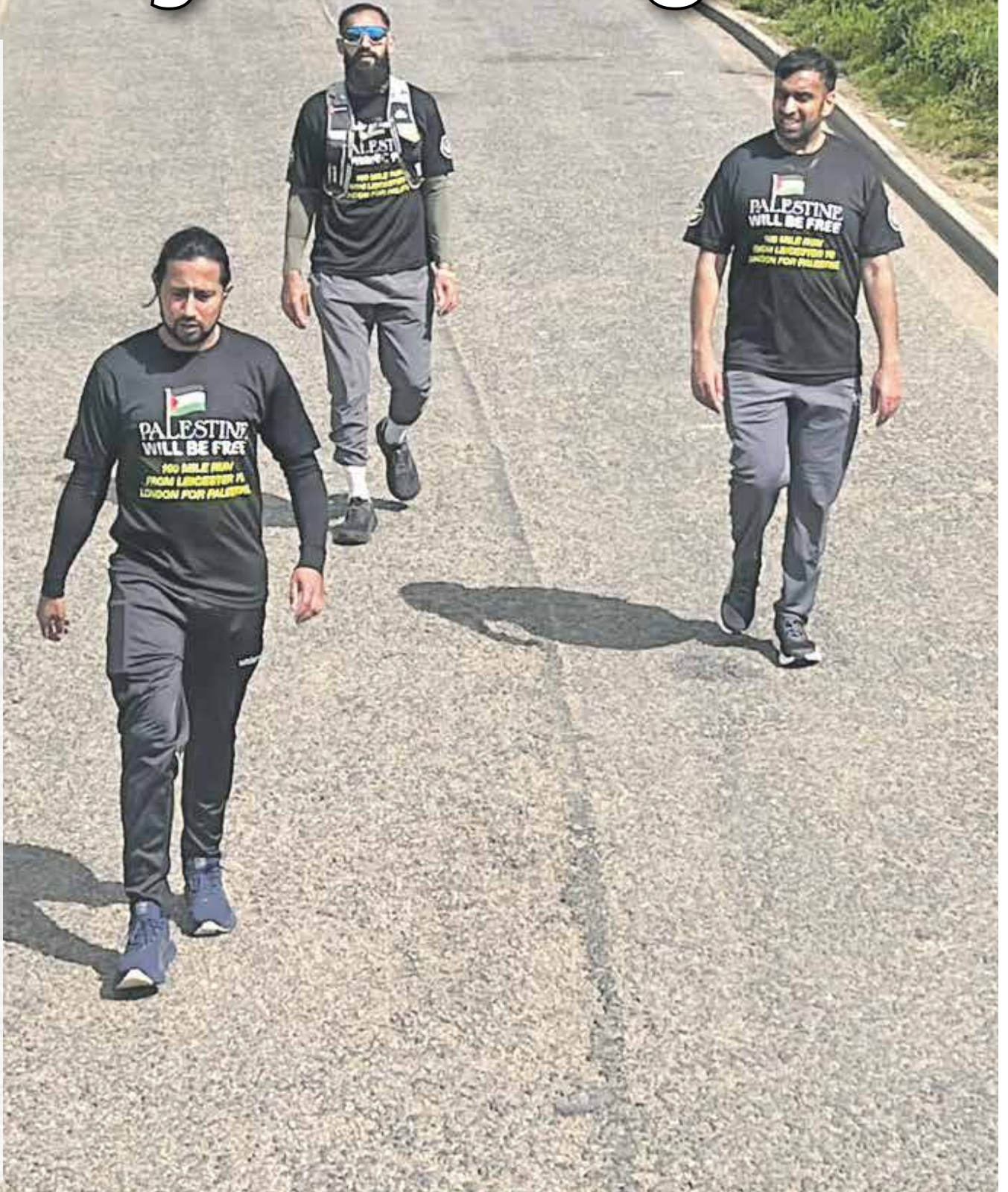
A dedicated support team included Ansar, Jamil, Naheem and Umar, who followed them by car, offering hydration, meals, and medical assistance throughout the journey.

Mosques in Leicester, Luton, and London opened their doors to the runners, offering food, prayers, and encouragement.

"We couldn't have done this without the incredible support from our communities. The way people came together - whether cheering us on, donating, or praying for us - was deeply humbling," said the runners.

"It showed us the true spirit of compassion and unity that defines our faith and our people."

The run has already raised £21,000 and the total is expected to reach £25,000 in the coming days. All donations will go directly to Islamic Relief UK's Gaza appeal, helping fund emergency relief operations, medical aid, and food distribution to families on the ground.
